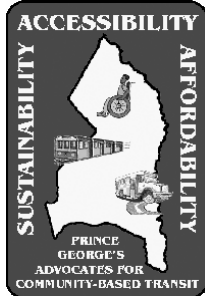


Prince George's ACT 2006 candidate scorecard



Prince George's ACT advocates accessible transit and livable communities for Prince George's County. Our priorities include: (1) rail on the Wilson Bridge, (2) the Inner Purple Line, (3) increased and improved bus and rail service, and (4) quality transit-oriented development. We surveyed all candidates for prominent state and county offices regarding their positions on the above issues.
